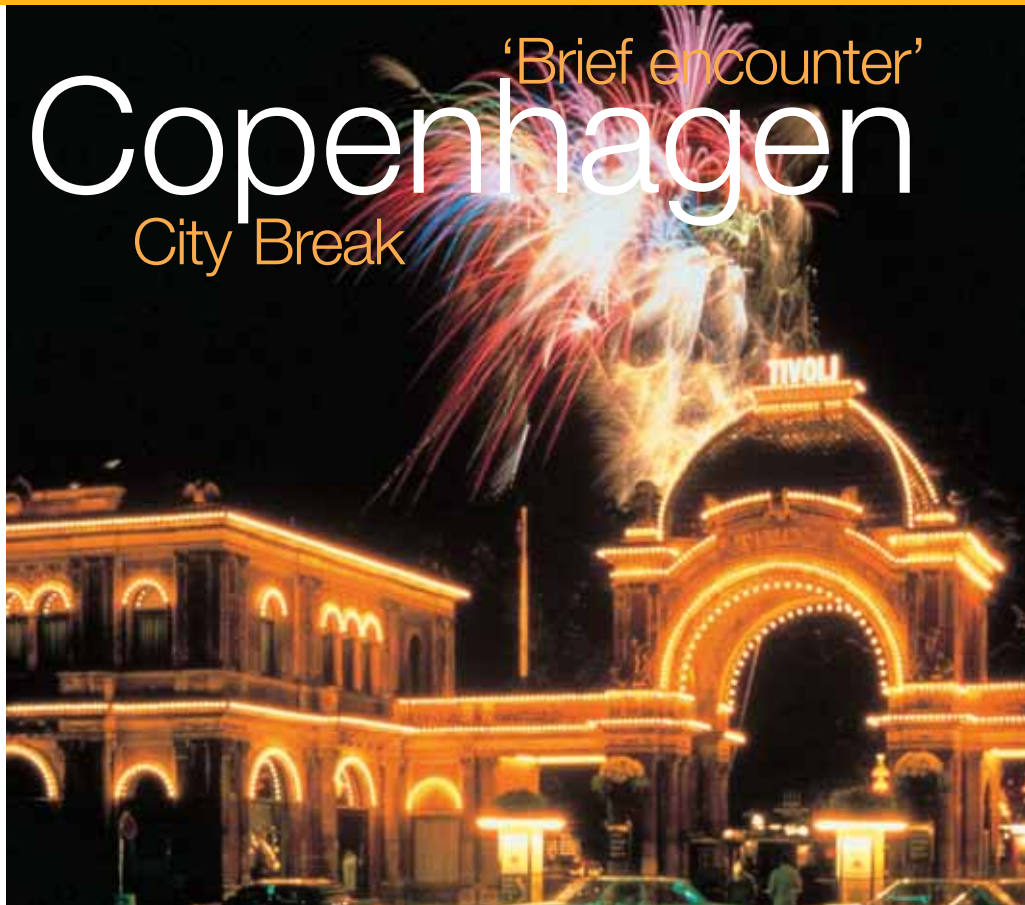
The trendy hotel bar, is a popular meeting place for Copenhagen locals, and you can enjoy a tasty evening meal in the restaurant.
