

Experience the extraordinary, unique and glistening Ice Hotel at Jukkasjarvi deep in the heart of Swedish Lapland. Enjoy traditional Sami cuisine; the Absolut Ice Bar; and snowmobile, reindeer and husky safaris for a thrilling holiday with a difference.

Each December, using the skills of several different Scandinavian ice sculptors, the celebrated Ice Hotel is crafted from 30,000 tons of snow and ice. The entire structure melts away each spring. Each year's design differs, the final detail being revealed only when the last ice block is in place and the last bedroom finished.

The hotel consists of Absolut Bar, art gallery, consecrated chapel, 'hall of pillars' and a choice of snow rooms, ice rooms or art suites all sculpted from ice. Guests sleep in special thermal Arctic sleeping bags on ice beds topped with reindeer skins.

The wider complex also includes a restaurant serving traditional Lappish food and "warm accommodation" of differing types. There are 'Kaamos' rooms with private wc/shower; 10 Nordic chalets with two bedrooms (one double and one with bunk beds) kitchenette and private shower/wc and 20 Northern Lights cabins. The latter have one double and one single bedroom, private wc/shower and skylights through which you can see the stars of the Arctic night.

All cabin types are of an identical standard with respect to furnishings and decor.

Our 'Ice Safari' takes you up to the Ice Hotel in Swedish Lapland on early morning scheduled flights with SAS via Stockholm for a three night stay to which you can add your excursions on a 'pick and mix' basis

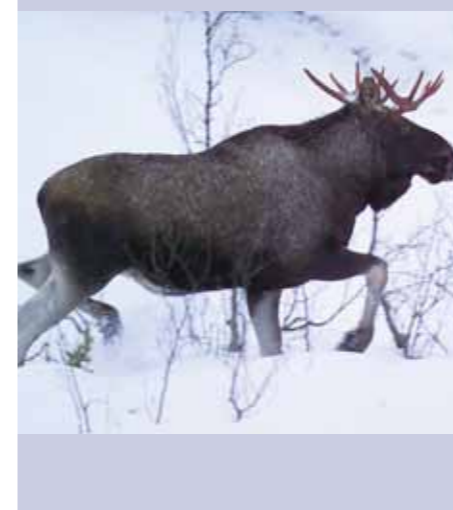
PRE-BOOKABLE EXCURSIONS

HUSKY SAFARIS

AA01 Travel along a 13 km trail through the surrounding forest with only the swish of the sled's runners to be heard. En route, stop for coffee and cake by an open fire. £140 pp

AA02 A four hour husky safari along 28 km of marked trails in the surrounding wilderness. A stop for a traditional Sami lunch by an open fire is included before returning to Jukkasjarvi. £265 pp

AA03 Start your visit to the Ice Hotel with a very special and unique form of airport transfer! On arrival, you will be kitted out with protective thermal clothing and your luggage taken separately to the hotel, whilst you enjoy your first taste of tranquil Sami landscapes on husky sled. (based on 4 people sharing) £135 pp



SNOWMOBILE SAFARIS

AA04 After a short instruction period with your guide, this snowmobile safari, lasting approximately two hours is fun for boys and girls alike. £85 pp

AA05 A 3 hour guided snowmobile safari along 28 km of marked trails in the surrounding wilderness. A stop for a traditional Sami lunch by an open fire is included before returning to Jukkasjarvi. £140 pp

AA06 A 4 hour guided evening tour in search of the Northern Lights with a traditional Sami dinner at a wilderness encampment. £155 pp

AA07 Start your visit to the Ice Hotel with a high speed, hardcore transfer: a snowmobile safari along marked trails in the boreal forest of spruce and pine and on the frozen surface of river Torne £155 pp.

MOOSE SAFARI

AA08 A 4½ hour trip, initially by minibus and thereafter by snowmobile, to the grazing pastures of the moose. £90 pp

REINDEER SAFARI

AA09 A four hour trip to a traditional Sami encampment including instruction and short reindeer safari including lunch in a Lavvo. £150 pp



ICE SCULPTING

AA10 A three hour back to primary school session learning how to fashion your own sculpture out of a single block of ice. Tuition by somebody involved in building the hotel. £60 pp
